Organic Waste Recycling



Per California Senate Bill 1826 (SB 1826), The Association will soon be required to comply with recycling organic waste here in the community. Waste Management will be dropping off a new 35

gallon green recycle bin behind each the garage and carports of every single unit here in the community. Delivery is scheduled for Saturday 6/4/2022. You will receive a separate notice outlining when service will begin as well as additional information and instructions.

Organic materials include food scraps, meats, dairy, fish, fruits, vegetables, coffee grounds and bakery items. Soiled paper goods, coffee filters, tea bags, soiled paper towels, napkins, and uncoated take out containers are included as well as yard waste. Additional information and instructions will be provided through Waste Management as the date draws nearer.

Bulk Item Trash Pickup

Waste Management will pick up bulk/large items up to 4 times per year for each resident at no cost. Call Waste Management directly at 619-596-5100 to schedule pickup. Do not leave bulk/large items anywhere on the property.

Cart Service Reminders

- 1. Place all materials in the appropriate container and close the lid.
- 2. All trash, recyclables and organics outside the cart will not be collected.
- 3. Place your carts at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on collection day. Emptied carts must be removed from curbside by 6:00 p.m. on the same day.
- 4. Roll carts into the street and place them against the curb, handles facing your home. Place carts at least two feet apart from other carts and objects.

Bulky Item Collection

Residents receive up to two (2) free bulky item pick-ups per year, with up to three (3) items per pick-up. Additional items may be picked up for a fee. Bulky items

cannot exceed 300 lbs. each. Please contact Waste Management Customer Service at least 24 hours in advance of your regular service day to schedule the pick-up.

Acceptable items include: Household furniture and appliances, such as sofas, chairs, washers, dryers, toilets, etc.

Non-acceptable items include: tires, batteries, paints, oils, construction debris, chemicals of any kind, Freon, rocks, sand, gravel, dirt, logs, carpet, hazardous or medical waste or items requiring more than two persons to safely handle.

Holiday Schedule

Collection does not occur on the following holidays:

- New Year's Day
- Memorial Day
- 4th of July
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

When a holiday falls on a weekday, collection will be delayed one day for the remainder of the week. If a holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no delay in service.
